## IPN Buildings are Fireproof

- Fireproof does not mean fire-immune
- Structural portions of the building will not burn
- Contents will burn causing dangerous heat and smoke
- Generally fire is contained in the portion of the building where the fire started

### If the fire is in your apartment

- Leave
- Close your door
- Call 911
- Tell neighbors on your floor
- Go down at least two flights

### If the fire is elsewhere in the building

## STAY IN YOUR APARTMENT

(Unless NYFD instructs you to leave)

- Do not enter smoke-filled hallways – smoke can kill.
- Call 911 to report fire/smoke
- Keep your door **CLOSED** and sealed with tape or wet towels.
- If flames and smoke are *NOT* right below you, open windows a few inches at top and bottom
